Maryland Youth Ballet is "Shining InThe Spotlight" with its 2013 Gala Entire District 20 State Delegation & Catherine Leggett serving as Honorary Co-Chairs

Silver Spring, MD - (January 28, 2013) – The Maryland Youth Ballet (MYB) will be "Shining In The Spotlight" on Saturday **March 2** as the non-profit dance institution hosts its 2013 gala at the Silver Spring Civic Building to spotlight its award-winning programs and community contribution.

Montgomery County's First Lady, **Catherine Leggett** and the entire Maryland District 20 delegation (**Senator Jamie Raskin, Delegate Sheila E. Hixson, Delegate Tom Hucker** and **Delegate Heather R. Mizeur**) are all serving as Honorary Gala Committee Co-Chairs.

Bethesda-based jazz band "Chaise Lounge" will be the entertainment for the evening. The night will also feature dinner, drinks, dessert, dancing, a 50/50 raffle, and live and silent auction items.

Two MYB programs, bringing the joy of movement to children who may never have the opportunity otherwise, will especially benefit from this year's gala:

- 1. **Music & Motion:** The only program of its kind in the United States, MYB's Music & Motion is a dance class for children with physical disabilities such as cerebral palsy. With the use of a custom-designed and installed suspension system, these children are able to stand, dance, and twirl without the use of their walkers or wheelchairs.
- 2. **JumpStart**: This MYB outreach program offers free, after-school ballet classes at local elementary schools and a free week-long, all-day summer dance program at MYB for children who cannot afford these classes, but may have the potential to be successful dancers in the future.

MYB is truly a unique and outstanding resource in the community and dance world:

- The non-profit currently trains more than 1,600 students age 2 to 80+ years
- For **42** years, MYB's core mission has been to prepare young dancers for a career in dance by providing the highest quality of classical ballet training.

- MYB is nationally known for placing its graduates among the top classical ballet companies in the world, with alumni currently dancing with American Ballet Theatre (ABT), New York City Ballet, Joffrey Ballet, Pennsylvania Ballet, and Mark Morris Dance, to name just a few.
- Student dancers present professional quality performances throughout the year reaching an audience of more than **15,000**.
- In addition, MYB offers dance classes to adults of all ages, some of whom have been dancing with MYB for decades.
- All of these programs are taught by MYB outstanding professional faculty who had careers with ballet companies and now share their experience and wisdom at MYB.
