What is it?

The Tea is intended for Nutcracker fans ages 2-5 (Dance with Me, Little Dancer, and Creative Movement). No dance experience is necessary and guests do not need to be MYB students.

When and where is it?

One party will be Saturday, November 29 from 10:00am-11:00am; The other party will be Sunday, December 21 from 10:00am-11:00am. Both will be held in Studio E at Maryland Youth Ballet.

What is the cost?

Registration is \$20 per ticket, which will allow one child and accompanying adult.

How do I register?

You may sign up at the office or online by November 21 for the 11/29 Party or December 12 for the 12/21 Party. You will need to fill out a small registration form and pay at that time to reserve your spot. Space will be limited to 20 guests.

Do I (parents) have to stay?

Yes, because of the age of the participants, an adult should accompany each guest. This will also give you the chance to use your own camera for photo opportunities with the characters.

Can boys come?

Absolutely. It is centered entirely on the Nutcracker and is not gender-specific.

What will be served?

We will offer tea, juice, water, and "Mother Ginger" cookies. There will NOT be any peanut products.

What do the kids need to wear?

Guests can wear absolutely anything. Guests will have the chance to take their picture with the Sugar Plum

No, the guests will not be dancing.
