Sleeping Beauty Dedding Celebration

What is it?

The Sleeping Beauty Wedding Celebration is a themed ballet party inspired by Act III of Sleeping Beauty, which will be featured in MYB's Spring Concert. It is targeted for young students who may not be ready to attend the full-length show. There will be dancing, games, crafts, snacks, and an in-studio viewing of the Act III rehearsal. The party will be lead by Ms. Kristin and student helpers.

Who can attend?

The party is designed for MYB's Creative Movement & Ballet I, and Ballet II students. Students should be MYB students, or a guest of an MYB student (limit 1). Guests need to have turned 4 or older by September 1, 2014.

When and where is it?

Sunday, March 15 from 2:30pm - 4:30pm at MYB (Studio E). The Sleeping Beauty rehearsal will be in Studio A at 3:00pm. The rehearsal is approximately 30 minutes.

What is the cost?

Registration is \$35 per guest. Parent/sibling tickets are available for the open rehearsal for \$5, limit of 2 per guest.

How do I register?

You may sign up online or at the office by March 7, 2015. You will need to fill out a small registration form and pay at that time. Space will be limited to 20 party quests. Spots can only be reserved upon receipt of payment and registration form.

Do I (parents) have to stay? What if I want to stay?

Parents do not need to stay. Due to space limitations, we will ask parents to wait in the hallway during the party. You may purchase a Parent/Sibling ticket if you would like to watch to open rehearsal (limit 2 per guest). It will run from 3:00pm - 3:30pm in Studio A. If you drop your dancer(s) off, please leave a good contact number for the day of the party in case of an emergency.

Can boys come?

Absolutely. All are welcome!

What are the snacks?

Parents will receive an email prior to the event with a list of all snacks that we will have available for guests. You are welcome to pack additional snacks/food as well as let us know of any allergies or other concerns at that time. There will NOT be any peanut products.

What do the kids need to wear?

Guests can wear anything, but it is recommended they wear comfortable clothing they can move in. Ballet attire, tutus, and wedding wear are optional. Ballet shoes or socks are fine.

Is there a ballet class?

There will be dancing and movement games, but it will not be a formal technique class.

Is there a performance?

Party guests will have the opportunity to watch an open rehearsal of Sleeping Beauty, Act III. Please understand this is still a rehearsal for our students, and will not be a formal performance.

May I purchase tickets just for the Sleeping Beauty rehearsal without the party?

The Parent/Sibling tickets are only available with a registered party guest.
