Sugar Plum Party*

What is it?

The Sugar Plum Party is holiday celebration centered on "The Nutcracker". There will be dancing, games, crafts, snacks, and a visit from the Sugar Plum Fairy.

Who can attend? Can I bring a friend/neighbor/cousin...?

The party is intended for Nutcracker fans ages 5-8 (Ballet I, II, & III). Students should be MYB students, or a guest of an MYB student (limit 1). All guests need to be 5 or older by September 1, 2015. Please consider that the level of dancing and games may not be appropriate for older siblings.

When and where is it?

One party will be Saturday, November 28 from 1:00pm – 3:00pm; the other party will be Saturday, December 19 from 3:00pm – 5:00pm. Both will be held in Studio E at Maryland Youth Ballet.

What is the cost?

Registration is \$30 per guest.

How do I register?

You may sign up at the office by November 20th for the November Party or December 10th for the December Party. You will need to fill out a registration form and pay cash or check at that time to reserve your spot.

Do I (parents) have to stay? What if I want to stay?

No- parents do not need to stay. It's a gift for kids and grown-ups! If you choose to drop off your dancer(s), please leave a good contact number for the day of the party if we need to reach you in case of an emergency. Due to space limitations, we will ask parents that stay to wait in the hallway during the party.

Can boys come?

Absolutely. It is centered entirely on the Nutcracker and is not gender-specific.

What do the kids need to wear?

Guests can wear anything, but it is recommended they wear comfortable clothing they can move in. Ballet attire, tutus, and tiaras are optional. Ballet shoes or socks are fine.

Is there a ballet class?

No. There will be dancing and games, but it is not a ballet technique class.

Is there a performance?

The Sugar Plum Fairy will perform her variation for the guests.
