Maryland Youth Ballet's RODEO ROUND UP

What is it?

The Rodeo Round Up is a rodeo-themed ballet party inspired by "Caroline Goes to the Rodeo", one of the ballet's featured in MYB's Spring Concert. It is targeted for young students who may not be ready to attend the full-length show. There will be dancing, games, crafts, snacks, and an in-studio viewing of a "Caroline Goes to the Rodeo" rehearsal. The party will be led by Ms. Kristin and student helpers. Parent/sibling tickets are available to view the rehearsal.

Who can attend?

The party is recommended for MYB's Creative Movement & Ballet I students. MYB students may bring one guest but all guests should have turned 4 or older by September 1, 2016. Dance experience is not necessary.

When and where is it?

The party will be Saturday, April 1, 2017 from 2:00pm - 4:00pm in Studio E at the MYB studios. The "Caroline Goes to the Rodeo" rehearsal will be in Studio A around 2:30pm. The rehearsal is approximately 30 minutes.

What is the cost?

Registration is \$30 per guest.

Parent/sibling tickets are available for the working rehearsal for \$5 each, limit of 2 per round-up guest.

How do I register?

You may register online or at the office by March 15. Space is limited.

Do I (parents) have to stay? What if I want to stay?

Parents do not need to stay. Due to space limitations, we will ask parents to wait in the hallway during the party. You may purchase a Parent/Sibling ticket if you would like to watch the Working Rehearsal (limit 2 per round-up guest). The rehearsal will run from 2:30pm-3:00pm in Studio A. If you drop your dancer(s) off for the party, we ask you leave a good contact number in case of emergency.

Can boys come?

Absolutely! All cowboys and cowgirls are welcome!

What do the kids need to wear?

Guests can wear anything, but it is recommended they wear comfortable clothing they can move in. Ballet attire, tutus, and western gear are optional. Cowboy boots are welcome, but will have to wait by the studio door; ballet shoes and socks are fine.

Is there a ballet class?

There will be dancing and movement games, but it will not be a formal technique class.

Is there a performance?

Party guests will have the opportunity to watch an working rehearsal of "Caroline Goes to the Rodeo". Please understand this is still a rehearsal for our students, and will not be a formal performance.

May I purchase tickets just for the "Caroline goes to the Rodeo" rehearsal without the party?

The Parent/Sibling tickets are only available with a registered party guest.
